2018 POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

General. The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all persons to assure safe and sanitary operation of the swimming pool related facilities. The cooperation of the members will afford pleasant relaxation and recreation for everyone concerned. Members are requested to caution their children and the children of their guests, to observe the pool rules and regulations and to obey the instructions of the pool attendant and the lifeguards. Any failure to comply with the pool rules and regulations shall be considered sufficient cause for members to be deprived of the use of the swimming pool by the pool attendant, lifeguard on duty, the Pool Manager or the Club Manager.

Management of the Pool. Set forth below are the Pool Rules and Regulations for Cypress Point Country Club (the "Club). All matters relating to the use of the swimming pool shall be controlled by the Club.

Hours of Operation. The pool season begins on the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend and closes after the Monday of Labor Day weekend. The hours that the swimming pool shall be open for use shall be 10 AM – 8 PM daily unless otherwise posted and are subject to change for special events. The Club will make every effort to notify members in advance of scheduled events and closings. The Club reserves the right to establish one day per week on which the swimming pool will be closed for necessary cleaning and maintenance. The day on which the swimming pool will be closed for cleaning and maintenance will be posted by the Club.

Registering. All members of the Club, their family members, and their guests must register with the pool attendant or lifeguard on duty upon entering the swimming pool area. The name of each member, family member, and guest must appear on the daily swimming pool attendant sheets maintained by the Club.

Closing of the Pool. The Pool Manager shall determine when the swimming pool shall be closed due to weather or maintenance conditions and shall further determine when the swimming pool may be reopened for use.

Refusal of Privileges. The Pool Manager shall have the right to refuse swimming pool privileges to anyone who, in the judgment of the Club Manager, violates established rules and decorum.

Personal Property. Members are reminded not to leave personal property unattended in the swimming pool area. The Club and the Owner shall not be responsible for lost or stolen personal property.

Guests. Pool members must obtain a pool pass for all local or out-of-town guests. Full members of the Club are encouraged to visit the club's accounting office to arrange for guest privileges. Pool members may bring guests to the pool and the fee is \$5 per guest per day. Should a pool member require multiple days of guest privileges then arrangements must be made with the Club's accounting office.

It is our intent to allow our several membership categories to enjoy our pool amenities. Guest fees are payable inside the Clubhouse or at the pool. Pool privileges for local guests are limited to the use of the swimming pool no more than five times per year. Pool privileges for out-of-town guests are limited to the use of the swimming pool for seven days per season.

Reserving the Pool. Members only

There is no cost to Club Members and Pool Members to reserve the pool and pool area. However, there is a lifeguard fee.

- For every 50 people there must be two lifeguards. \$20 an hour for 50 people or less
- For 51 or more people there must be three lifeguards. \$30 an hour for 51 people or more

For all Pool Parties/Events

No outside food or beverages are allowed apart from desserts.
 We are unable to serve alcohol in the pool area unless food is provided by Cypress Point Country Club.

Security Deposits:

\$250 for 50 people or less \$500 for 51 people or more

Liability for Personal Injury or Property Damage.

All members should note carefully the following information:

- A. The Club and the Owner assume no responsibility or liability whatsoever for any injury or damage caused to persons or property resulting from the use of the swimming pool.
- B. Any person using the swimming pool shall immediately report to the pool attendant or lifeguard on duty and/or the Club Manager any injury or damage to persons or property caused by such person.

Amendments. The Club reserves the right in the exercise of its sole discretion to amend these rules and regulations from time to time. Any such amendments made to these rules and regulations shall be posted by the Club.

Swim Wear. Any person using the swimming pool shall dress in appropriate swim wear. No person shall be permitted to wear shorts, "cut-offs," etc., in the swimming pool.

Pool Attendant and Lifeguards. No person shall use the swimming pool unless the swimming pool is officially opened and the pool attendant or lifeguard is on duty. All persons shall obey the instructions of the pool attendant and the lifeguards. All persons must stay clear of the lifeguard stations and shall not loiter at the check-in desk.

Health Requirements. Use of the swimming pool and admission to the swimming pool area may be refused for any person having a cold, cough, inflamed eyes, infection, wearing a bandage, or having an open sore or any other unusual physical condition that might affect the health and welfare or other persons using the swimming pool. All persons must take a cleansing shower before entering the swimming pool. Spouting of water and similar unhygienic actions in the swimming pool are not permitted at any time.

Adult Swim. The Club reserves the right in the exercise of its sole discretion to designate certain times for the exclusive use of the swimming pool by adult members and guests. The times of adult swim periods shall be posted by the Club and enforced by the pool attendant and/or lifeguard on duty.

Minor Children. Children five years and under must be accompanied by a responsible person at all times while swimming in the pool. Children nine years and under must be accompanied to the swimming pool area by an adult. The pool attendant and the lifeguards are empowered to deny swimming pool privileges to any child who cannot demonstrate satisfactory swimming ability. Children must be picked up at the swimming pool no later than posted or scheduled closing time for the swimming pool.

Safety Consideration.

- A. No running, pushing, dunking or rough play will be permitted in the swimming pool or the swimming pool area. Standing or sitting on another person's shoulders is not permitted.
- B. Persons unable to demonstrate to the lifeguards their ability to swim properly shall not be permitted in the deep water areas of the swimming pool. Diving or jumping into the swimming pool is prohibited.
- C. Glass containers, breakable objects, food and drinks are not permitted in the swimming pool area. No food or beverage shall be consumed in the swimming pool area. Food and beverage may be consumed only in designated refreshment areas. No outside food or beverages may be brought into the swimming pool area.
- D. Food orders can be given at the Members' Bar or ordered from the Members' Bar by phone to be picked up by pool patron. Please wear a cover-up over your swimsuit and enter from the outside door near the Pro Shop end of the clubhouse. Lifeguards will have menus available.
- E. No pets shall be permitted at any time in the swimming pool area.
- F. All refuse must be placed in containers provided for this purpose.

- G. Members are urged to assist in keeping the swimming pool and the swimming pool area clean.
 - H. Persons wearing glasses or goggles in the swimming pool must secure their glasses or goggles with an appropriate support band.
 - NO smoking is permitted in the swimming pool area.
 Smoking is permitted in designated refreshment areas only.
 - J. Members must provide towels for their use and the use of their family members and guests.

Pool Items ALLOWED:

Noodles/small inner tubes Flotation devices (water wings, life jackets) Water guns (if properly used) Water toys/beach balls/flippers/snorkels Goggles/water weights

Pool Items NOT ALLOWED:

Boogie boards Big floats

Conduct and Language. All persons using the swimming pool and in the swimming pool area shall conduct themselves in a manner so as not to disrupt or impair the use and enjoyment of the swimming pool by others. Profane or vulgar language is strictly prohibited. Violation of this rule may result in suspension of swimming pool privileges.

Liability. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. The Club and owner assumes no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with the use of the pool or for any loss or damage of personal property. Persons using the pool agree not to hold the Club or Owner personally liable for any actions of any kind whatsoever occurring in the pool areas. Members will be responsible for the actions of their guests or children of their guests.
